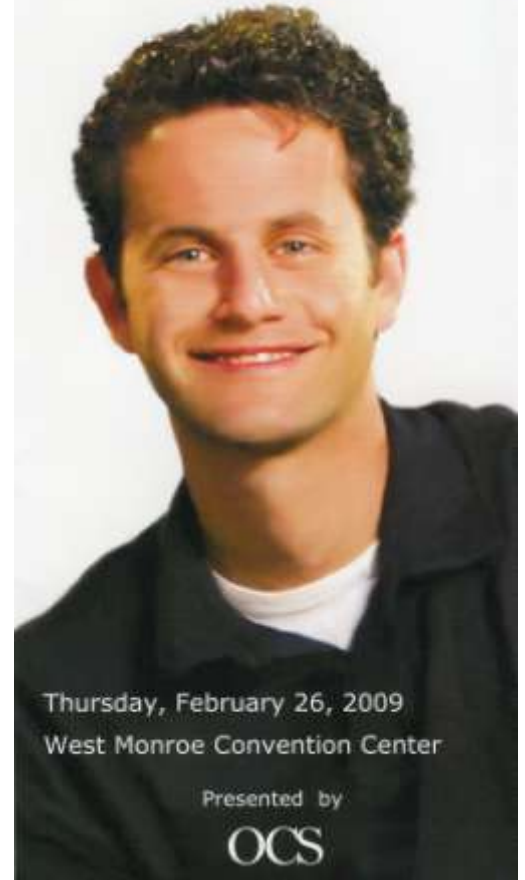
Sporting Clays Tournament.
