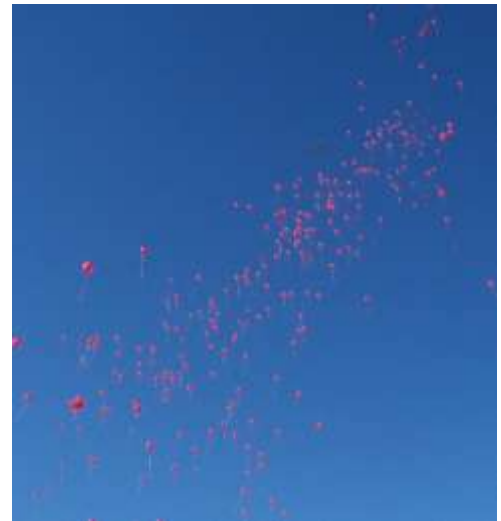

ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT



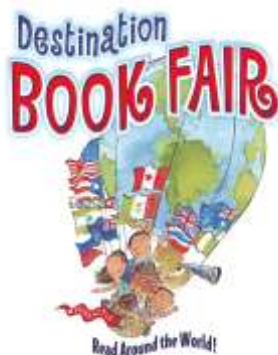
